Contents

The Institute for World Economics, Budapest has been involved in a major China project with the Hungarian Prime Minister's Office since 2006. As a result of this strategic research, some aspects of China's internal development and international relations have been analyzed. The first year of this project produced about 15 studies, two conferences and one book to be published soon – for the time being only in Hungarian.

The project will continue in 2007-08. In this stage, we are planning to organize a regional network of experts and younger people – dealing with or interested in China – not only in Hungary but also in the countries of Central and Eastern Europe.

The main aspects of the persistent research are the following:

- Internal reforms in the People's Republic of China
- Foreign relations - China and the Commonwealth of Independent States
- Foreign relations - China and the European Union
- Chinese people living in Hungary
- Hungarian-Chinese relations
